APPOINTMENT OF HIGH SCHOOL PRINCIPAL - Dr. Knudson reported on the recent national search for a high school principal. Approximately 20 applicants responded to our announcement of the position. Twelve applicants were screened and six of those sent to an Interview Committee comprised of faculty, staff, administration, parents and students. The Interview Committee met over two days to interview the six candidates; their reflections were sent to the Superintendent for consideration. Dr. Knudson indicated that while several very capable candidates applied for the position, Mrs. Nancy Striebich stood out as the best person to serve as the next Principal of Indian Hill High School. Mrs. Striebich's understanding of our student population, academic expectations and high degree of parent involvement were certainly advantages as well as her performance as interim principal this year. Dr. Knudson recommended a one-year contract for Mrs. Striebich to serve as Principal for the 2007-08 school year.
