APPOINTMENT OF MIDDLE SCHOOL PRINCIPAL - Dr. Knudson reported on the recent national search for a middle school principal. Approximately 22 applicants responded to our announcement of the position. Approximately fifteen applicants were screened and six of those sent to an Interview Committee comprised of faculty, staff, administration, parents and students. The Interview Committee met over two days to interview the six candidates; their reflections were sent to the Superintendent for consideration. Dr. Knudson indicated that while several very capable candidates applied for the position, Mrs. Kimberly Miller stood out as the best person to serve as the next Principal of Indian Hill Middle School. Mrs. Miller's experiences as a middle school language arts teacher, consultant for the Hamilton County Educational Service Center for State Standards and Gifted Education, and building administrator will serve the District well as she takes over the leadership of the Middle School. Her talent for collaboration and coaching enables success for teachers and students. Dr. Knudson recommended a one-year contract for Mrs. Miller to serve as Principal for the 2008-09 school year.
